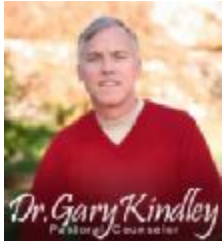

The main bathrooms are in the final phase of their completion! The project began as the contractors offered to add the bathroom flooring to the parlor's removal and abatement process without additional charge. In the process, we have discovered badly corroded pipe work in the walls-and some necessary updating was done to the plumbing. You will find the doors with locks for your convenience, tile that extends up the walls, fresh paint and a new welcoming environment!
